It was first adopted in 2011 by United Nation member States to raise awareness and increase the prevention of human trafficking and modern day slavery. Human Trafficking involves the recruitment, transporting or harboring of people into a situation of exploitation against their will, through the use of violence, deception or coercion. There is a rising determination to end this scourge, which has lead to a growth in movements against sexual harassment, violence, hard labour and discrimination against victims. The Oyo State Government under the amiable leadership of His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi is committed and is working intensely to ensure this menace is heavily resisted and reduced. The State is highly dedicated to both tracking down the perpetrators of these crimes as well as sponsoring various advocacy programs at both the grassroot and the urban centres. Through the State Emergency Management Agency and the Ministry of Women Affairs, victims are counseled and returned to their families especially the recent mass deportation of Nigerians from Libya, of

which a few have been successfully empowered by Oyo State Government.
